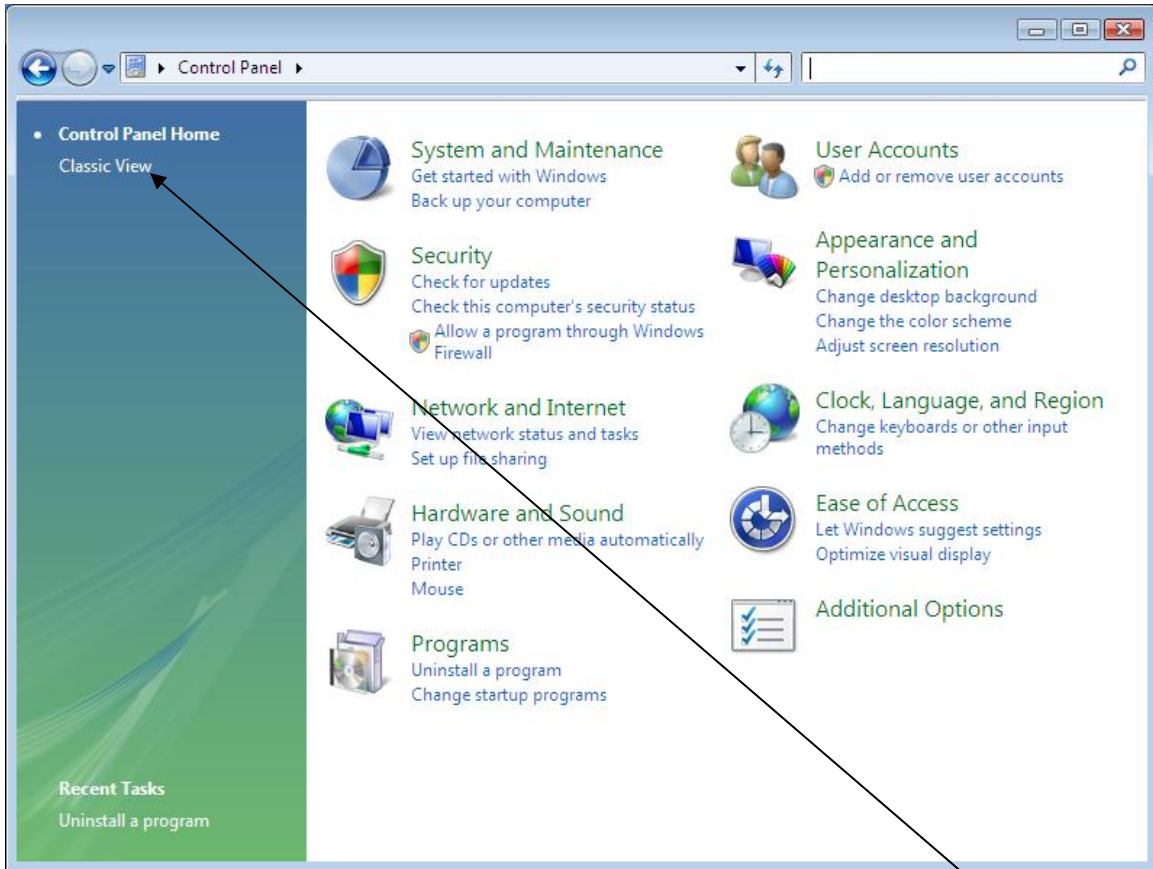


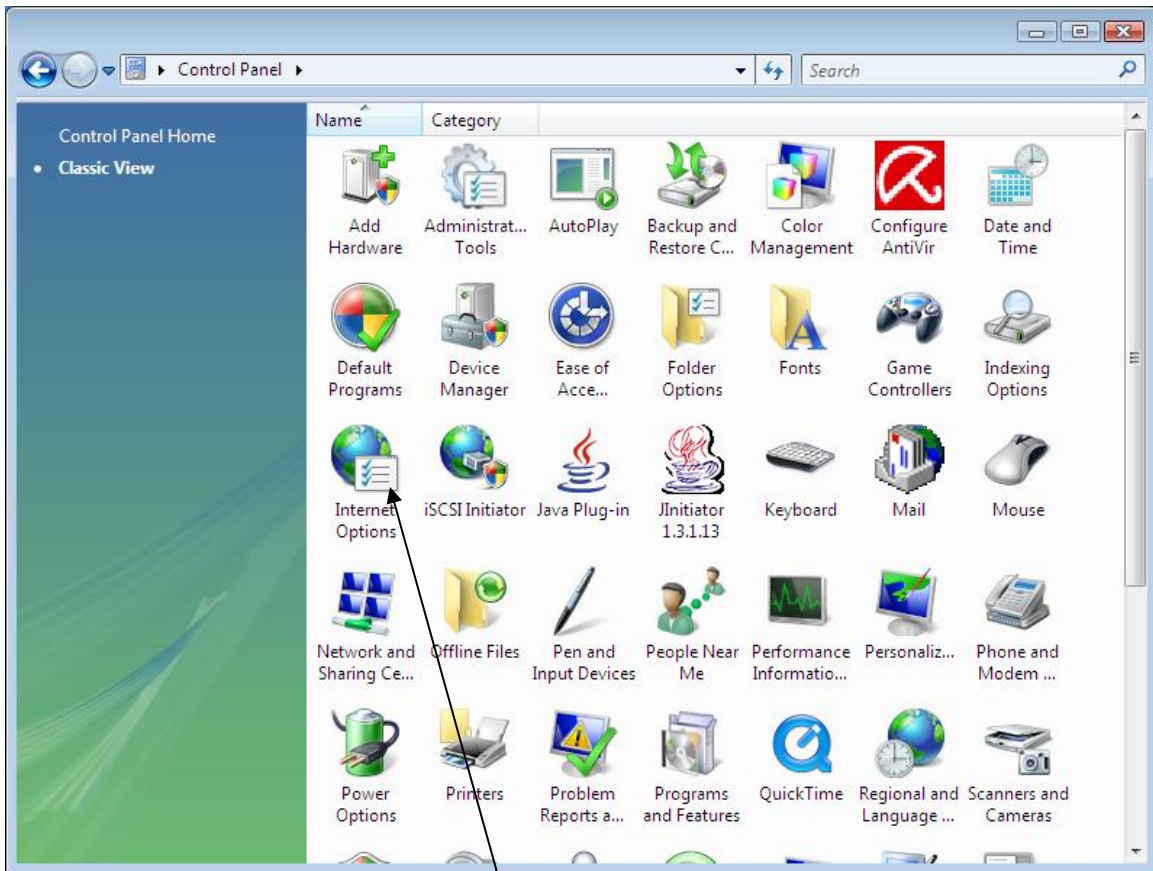
Setting Up a Dialer In Window Vista



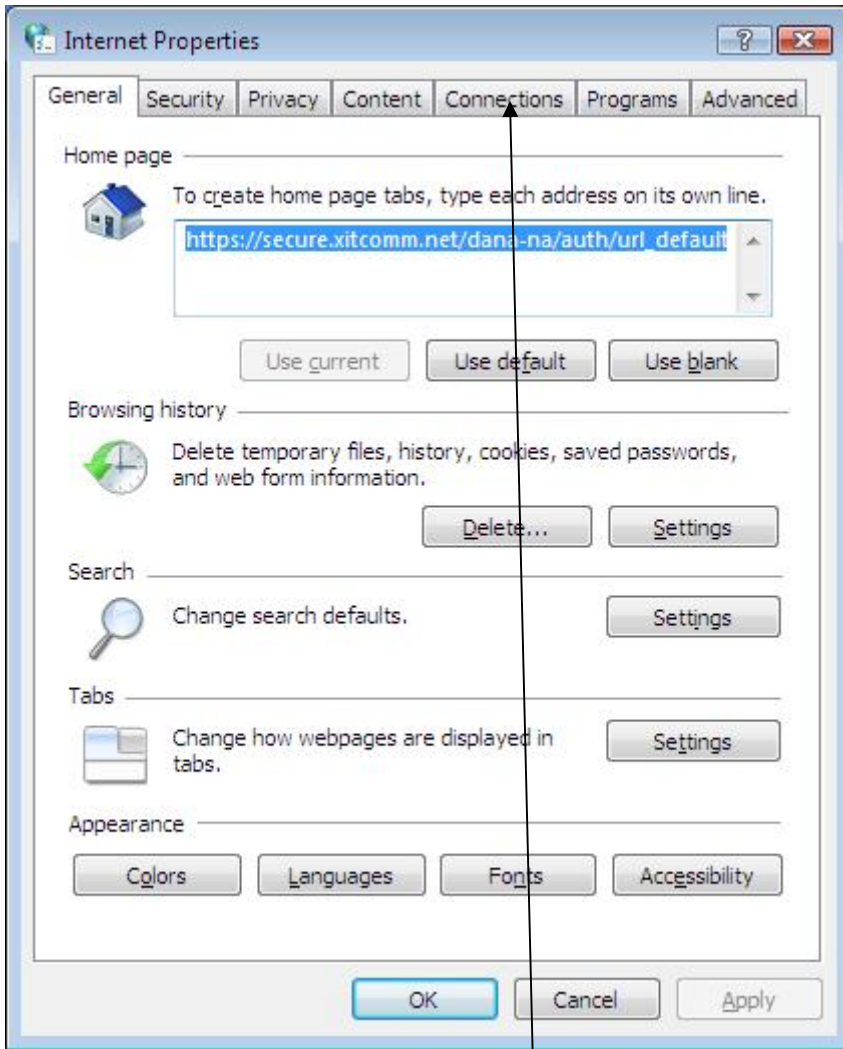
Left Click on the start menu and left click on the Control Panel



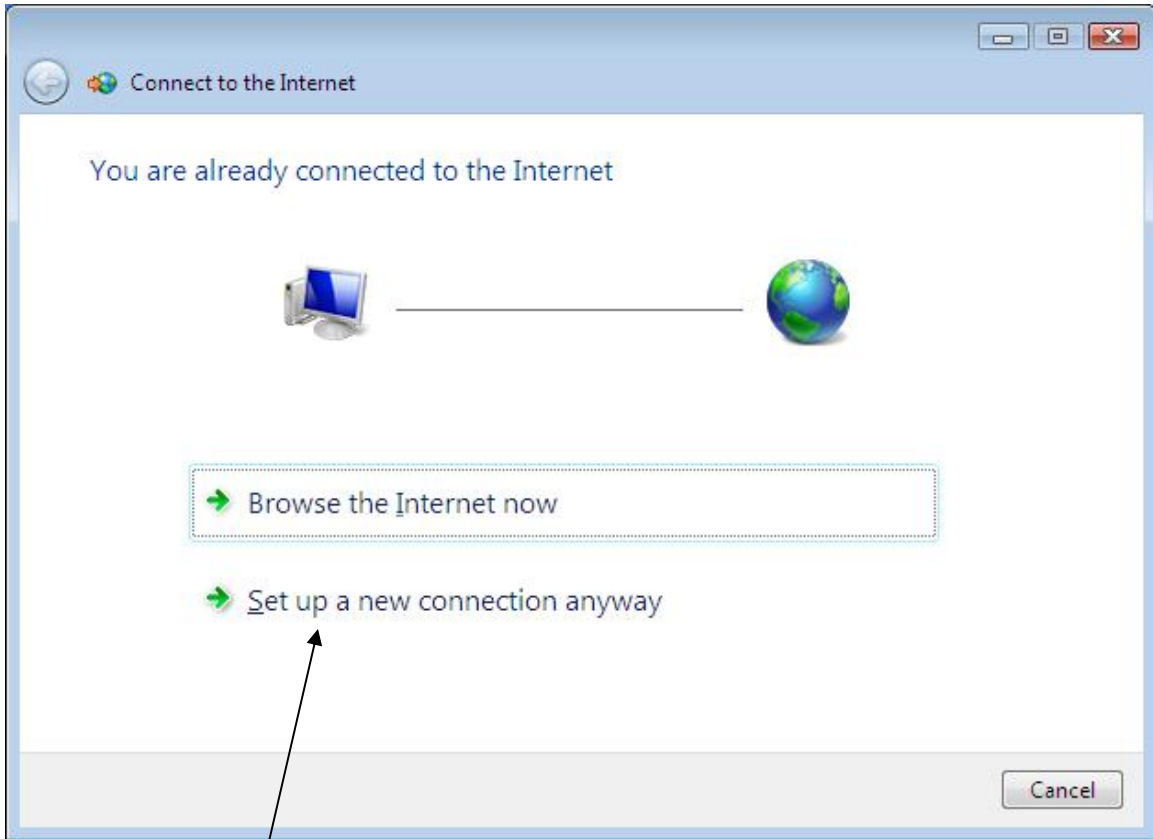
When the Control Panel opens you will want to left click on Classic View



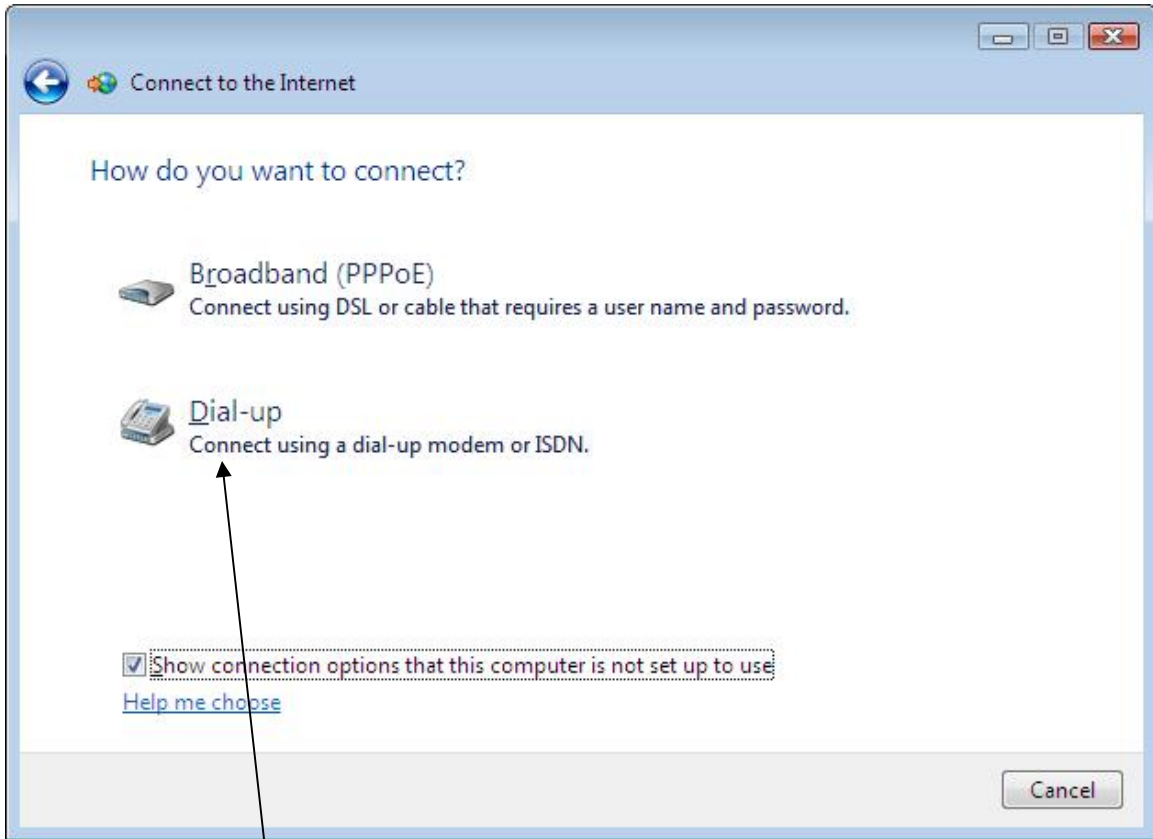
Now double left click on Internet Options

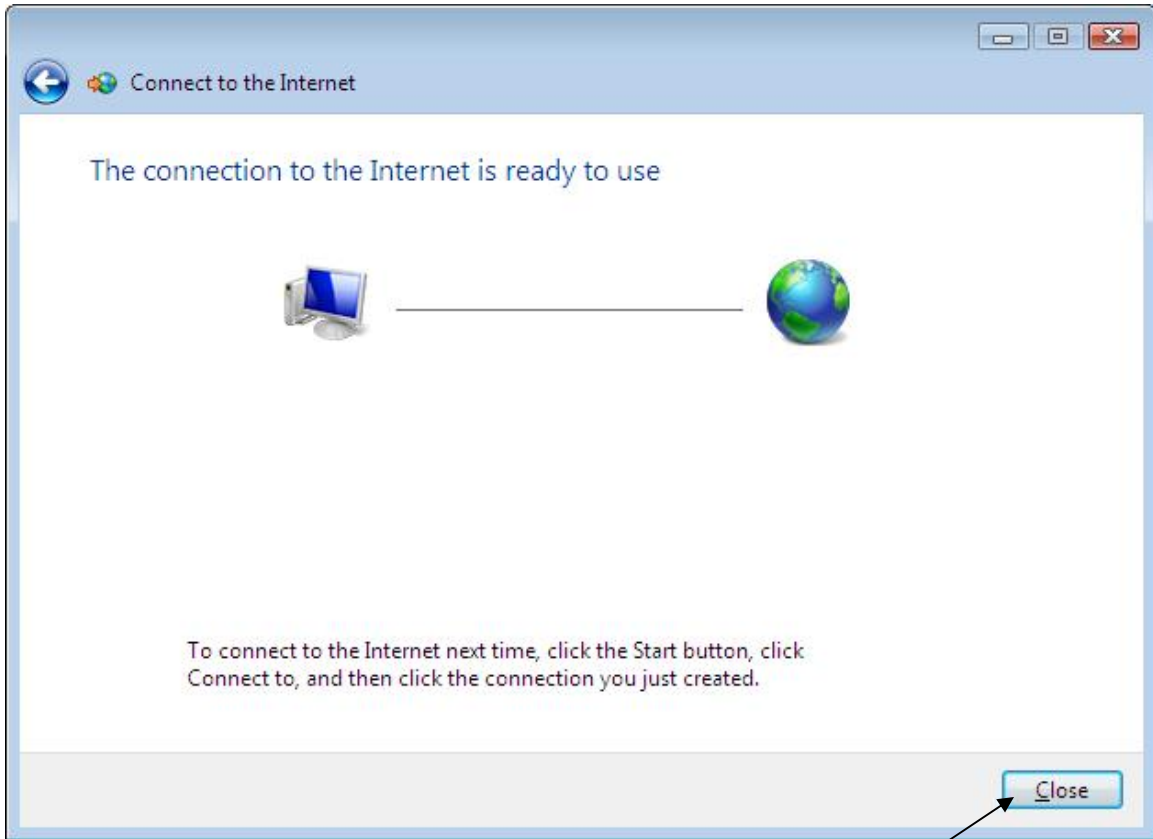

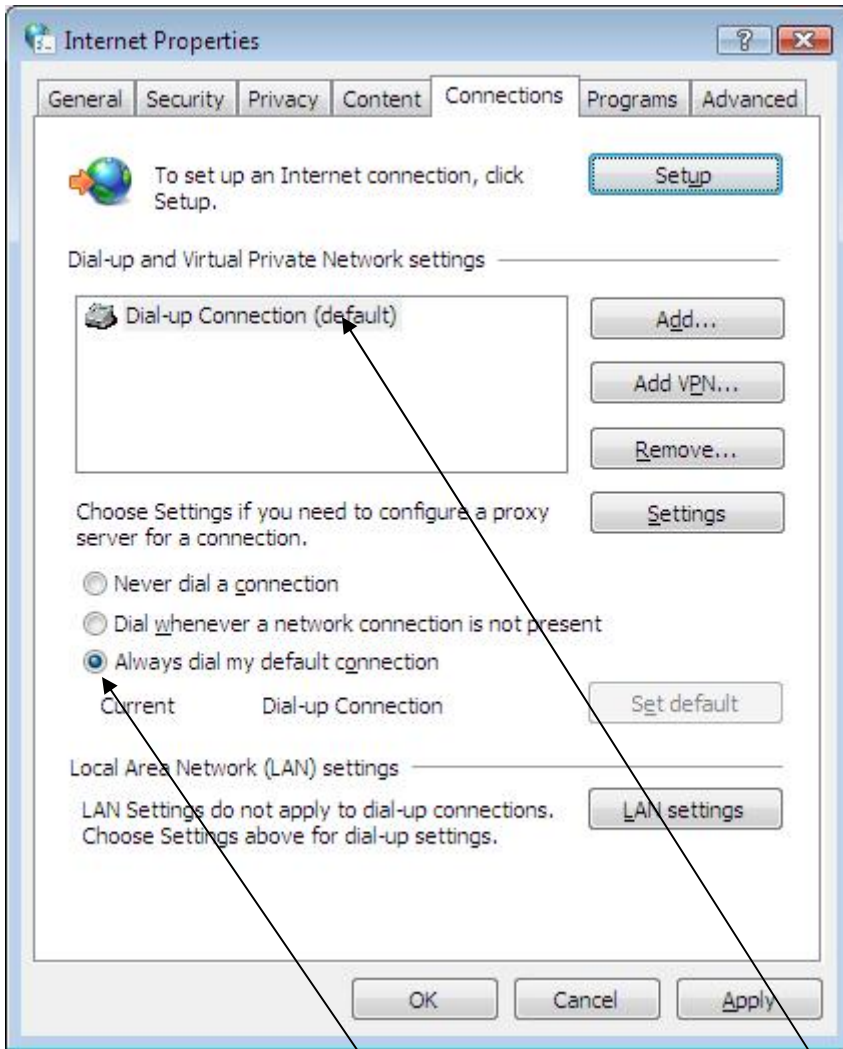
